- Stevanne Ellis highlighted the need for education, especially for providers in nursing homes and assisted living.
- Challenges in implementing effective training programs and the importance of hands-on training.

10. Concerns About Smaller Assisted Livings:

- Carol Fenderson expressed concerns about smaller assisted livings lacking resources for outside training.
- Issues related to funding, staff availability, and potential risks associated with providers seeing residents as a source of income.

11. Legislative Changes to Address Issues:

- Stevanne Ellis proposed legislative changes, including criminal penalties for certain situations and addressing financial exploitation and control by providers.
